Help for Tenants

You may be eligible for federal funding for rent due to the pandemic (even if you have not been ill with COVID).

Help is available if you've lost wages, experienced financial hardship, and whether or not you have an eviction case already filed. It is free to find out if you qualify.



Apply for rent relief funds

More than \$400 million in rental assistance has been authorized by the federal government for the state of Indiana.



Get help talking with your landlord

Free settlement conferences with landlords, tenants and a neutral facilitator allow all parties to discuss the situation and explore solutions.

If your landlord has already filed to evict you, it is not too late to apply for rental assistance or participate in fast-track facilitation.
